Class Attendance: Because of the nature of this course, formal class meetings are not required. However, periodic meetings and or contact should be made throughout the duration of the internship. Contact may be by phone, email, or in person.

Assignments/Paper: You are required to prepare a 10 or 20 page paper related to a topic(s) agreed upon during the summer session. The length of the paper relates to the number of academic credits you are taking.

Generally the paper should discuss/cover the following topics:

- Discussion of your job on-the-job experiences and assignments
- Relationship between your classroom experiences and your internship duties
- Discussion of how your classroom experiences helped you with your internship duties
- How your classroom experiences could have been improved to make you better prepared for your position
- What you learned about your potential career from this experience
- What changes you may or may not make regarding you potential career choice
- Other topics you consider relevant to your experience

Examinations: There will be no examinations for the course.

Grading: Your final grade will be determined on a pass/no pass basis. Grading is related primarily to the paper related to your internship program.

Learning Objective: The primary goal of the class is to gain practical experience related to you major by participating in a field internship program. You will have an onsite supervisor/mentor who will oversee you day-to-day activities. I am available to discuss your progress, questions you may have, or problems you may encounter.
