Major Performance Assignments:

A 1½ minute (90 seconds) comedic monologue from a style, period and playwright of your choice Due Tuesday 8/23/16

Major Reading Assignments:

One full-length contemporary American plays
One full-length play from a style, period and playwright of your choice *An Actor Prepares*, by Constantin Stanislavski *Building a Character*, by Constantin Stanislavski

Major Writing Assignments:

All papers must be typed.

Accompanying each performance assignment, a paper will be assigned. It will include a concise, yet in-depth analysis of the character you are playing, as well as, the play from which the monologue or scene has been taken.
